

GENEROSITY

2022 Total Giving: \$203,000

- Giving increased by 68% compared to 2021
- This funding increase helped cover rising costs in Haiti:
 - food
 - supplies
 - o gas
 - safe travel
- 95% of donations went straight to Haiti
- Close to \$5,000 was raised by youth entrepreneurs with a passion for supporting women in Haiti
- We partnered with DonorSee, an international giving platform, to expand our reach
 - DonorSee allowed us to connect with brand new supporters
 - DonorSee users donated over \$5,000 to various projects that supported the safe house, our residents, and our staff
